FAQ'S DEMOBIKE

What is the demobike?

The Demobike is an activity within the Sea Otter Europe festival that allows attendees to test different brands of bikes on specially designed circuits. It is an opportunity to experience first-hand the latest bike innovations in various categories.

What is the demobike schedule?

The Demobike schedule generally follows the festival opening hours. It has not yet been confirmed for 2024, but in previous editions it was held throughout the day within the festival opening hours. Please check the official website for more up-to-date information.

Which brands offer the demobike service?

Where are the brands located?

The brands that offer the Demobike service are located in designated areas within the festival grounds, with easy access to the test circuits.

How do I reserve a bike?

From 4th September you can reserve through our website for up to a maximum of 3 bikes (during the pre-booking period).

On the day of the festival go straight to the brand's stand. You must bring your ID (original Spanish national id. card DNI/Spanish foreigners' id. card NIE or passport). Once you have completed the tests, you can try as many circuits as you want, unlimited and free of charge.

What are the Demobike circuits?

The Demobike circuits include different routes adapted to different types of bikes and skill levels. These circuits allow you to test the bikes in real conditions representative of how you would use them. Click on the <u>Demobike Guide</u> to discover the circuits.

FAQ'S FESTIVAL

How can I get to the festival and where can I park?

The Sea Otter Europe festival takes place in Girona, and you can get there by car, public transport or bike. There are designated parking areas close to the venue. It is advisable to arrive in good time to avoid congestion and to secure a parking space.

What are the festival opening hours?

The festival opening hours on the Friday are from 12:00 to 19:30. On Saturday the festival starts at 09:00 and ends at 19:30. Lastly, on Sunday it starts at 09:00 and ends at 15:00.

Is entry free?

Yes, the entrance to the festival is free, although registration is required for access to the festival. Some activities, such as some sport events, require registration.

Which brands are exhibiting in 2024?

The brands exhibiting in 2024 will be announced on the official website nearer the time of the event. Leading brands in the cycling and mobility world are expected to participate. Are there vegans/vegetarian options?

Yes, the festival has vegan and vegetarian options in the food court to attend to all guests.

Is there Wi-Fi?

Yes, Wi-Fi is available in some areas of the festival. Details on how to connect to the Wi-Fi will be provided with the event information.

Is there transport from the event to the city centre?

Yes, there will be a shuttle bus available. It is recommended to park in the car park provided by the organisers and use the shuttle bus, which will run in a circular route between the two points every 15 minutes.

(Shuttle bus every 15 minutes) Save yourself the hassle of trying to park!

How can I get to the festival?

You can get to the festival by car, bike, public transport or on foot, depending on your location. The official website provides detailed directions to facilitate your arrival.

FAQ'S SPORT EVENTS

Are there showers?

Yes, the festival usually provides showers for the participants of the sport events. The specific location and times will be indicated in the event programme.

Is there a cloakroom service?

Yes, a cloakroom service is offered for sport event participants.

Can I rent a bike for a sport event?

Yes, you can rent bikes, but it is advisable to book in advance due to the high demand during the festival.
